IN RE: NOTICE OF INTENT OF CANTON MUNICIPAL UTILITIES TO SEEK AUTHORIZATION OF MISSISSIPPI PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION FOR RATES PREVIOUSLY LEVIED FOR WATER SERVICES WITHIN ITS CERTIFICATED AREA IN MADISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

RECOMMENDED ORDER APPROVING AMENDED FILING

THIS DAY, there came on for consideration before the Mississippi Public Service Commission (“the Commission”), the amended filing by Canton Municipal Utilities (“CMU”) seeking approval of monthly water rates, terms and conditions for the provision of water service in its Certificated Areas located in Madison County, Mississippi. Based upon the filing by CMU, as amended, the entire record of this matter and further based upon the recommendation of the Public Utilities Staff (“the Staff”), the Commission hereby finds, as follows:

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

1.

On November 29, 2016, CMU filed its Notice of Intent (“NOI”) seeking approval of monthly water rates, terms and conditions applicable to the residents located within its jurisdictional areas, which are located more than one-mile outside its corporate boundary. On June 1, 2017, CMU amended its NOI.

On December 5, 2016, and on June 14, 2017, the Commission issued Suspension Orders requesting that the Staff conduct a full investigation of the lawfulness of the NOI presented by CMU.

Due and proper notice of this Docket has been provided pursuant to applicable law. Publication of the filing was properly made, as reflected in the record hereof. In addition to publication, all affected customers were provided notice of CMU's NOI, which notice is contained within the record hereof.

On January 24, 2017, the Commission referred this Docket to its Vice-Chairman, Cecil Brown, for hearing, report and recommendation of an Order pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. §77-3-40(6).

On January 30, 2017, the Commission approved CMU's currently charged rates as temporary.

Preliminary hearings were conducted on September 27, 2018, and on July 30, 2019, to receive testimony and evidence.

On January 25, 2019, June 26, 2019, and July 11, 2019, the Commission issued Orders requiring CMU to file additional supporting documentation, data and calculations.

The Staff propounded numerous data requests to CMU, as part of its investigation of CMU's NOI, as amended. The Staff, after thoroughly reviewing and analyzing the voluminous documentation, data and calculations presented by CMU, recommends approval of the amended NOI and accompanying tariff proposed herein by CMU.

After weighing all the evidence and after studied deliberation, this Recommended Order is issued.

FINDINGS & ORDER

2.

CMU is a public utility, as defined in Miss. Code Ann. § 77-3-3 (d)(iv), and is engaged in the business of providing water service, to the public for compensation, to its customer base located

more than one (1) mile outside its corporate boundaries and within its Commission-issued Certificated Areas located within Madison County, Mississippi.

CMU increased its monthly water rates effective October 1, 2012, for its jurisdictional customer base without first seeking approval from the Commission. This Commission has the exclusive original jurisdiction to determine just and reasonable rates applicable to the water service provided by CMU to its jurisdictional customer base. Moreover, a municipally owned or operated public utility cannot lawfully alter the rates it charges its customers, who reside more than one-mile outside its corporate boundaries, unilaterally. Instead, the Commission is the regulatory body with the legislative authority to set such rates and rate schedules. (Miss. Code Ann. §77-3-1; §77-3-5; §77-3-35; and §77-3-37).

The Commission, acting pursuant to the authority granted it by Miss. Code Ann. §77-3-41, allowed CMU on January 30, 2017, to temporarily amend its last Commission-approved water rate structure and tariff to mirror the rates it was actually charging its jurisdictional customer base.

After reviewing all supporting documentation presented by CMU in this Docket, the Commission concludes that it is in the public interest that CMU remain in a financial position so that it can continue to provide reasonably adequate water service to its jurisdictional customer base. The Commission finds it to be in the public interest that the temporary rates previously approved by it shall become permanent water rates, until changed by a subsequent Commission Order. The Commission expressly places CMU on notice that it must comply with the laws governing the regulation of public utilities. The Commission will not look kindly upon another failure to comply with all applicable law and places Canton on notice that a failure to follow such laws could result in a refund of monies collected. In this case, the Commission determines that the water rates, charges and service extension policy proposed by CMU represent fair, just and

reasonable rates. The Commission hereby approves CMU's amended NOI, along with its proposed tariff, marked hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein.

Issues surrounding responses by CMU provided during the investigation of this Docket, regarding certain monetary transfers of revenue generated from jurisdictional water rates, between CMU, the City of Canton ("Canton"), the Canton Redevelopment Authority and possibly others have resulted in a parallel Docket being created by the Commission, Docket 2019-AD-109, also known as the "Transfers Docket." The Commission takes administrative notice of this Docket. The Commission has bifurcated the issues of questionable transfers, as discussed above, into the Transfers Docket; therefore, the Commission expressly reserves its jurisdiction to issue all appropriate orders on all issues that may arise in the Transfers Docket.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, that the filing of CMU, as amended, is approved, along with the attached tariff, marked as Exhibit "A" hereto, which tariff reflects the applicable schedule of rates, terms and conditions for the rendition of water service, to the public for compensation, within CMU's Certificated Areas located in Madison County, Mississippi.



IT IS, FURTHER, ORDERED, that exceptions to this Recommended Order may be filed by the parties, within fifteen (15) days from the date of entry of this Recommended Order, for the review of the full Commission in accordance with Miss. Code Ann. § 77-3-40. If exceptions are not timely filed, this Recommended Order shall then become the Order of the Commission.

This Order shall be deemed issued on the date it is served upon the parties herein by the Executive Secretary of this Commission who shall note the service date in the file of this Docket.

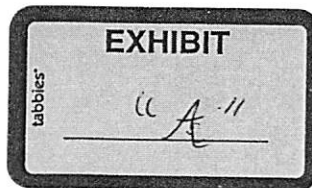

Application of Policy

The Service Extension Policy of Canton Municipal Utilities shall apply in those instances where the service in question is not readily available from a point on the existing system without a system extension and/or where the quantities are beyond the ability of the system to supply at the point where the service is requested.

Application for Service

In such instances the prospective customer shall make a written application for service in which he shall state the quantity of water service desired, the pressure desired and clearly define the point at which service is desired.

Estimate of Cost and Availability of Service

Canton Municipal Utilities will estimate or cause to be estimated the cost of providing the service requested at the point requested and will perform or cause to be performed a rate of return analysis based on the estimated total connection cost (except meter) and projected water consumption in order to consider the terms under which such service may be extended.

SERVICE EXTENSION POLICY (continued)

If such analysis indicates that the required extension has a pay back period of five (5) years or less, Canton Municipal Utilities will serve the required location, subject to the Service Rules and Regulations included herewith, at no cost to the prospective customer other than the duly approved fees and charges. However, if it was determined that the pay back period is more than five (5) years, CMU may decline service to the location unless a contribution-in-aid-of-construction is provided by the prospective customer to reduce the pay back period to five (5) years.

Contribution-in Aid-of-Construction

If a Contribution-in-Aid-of-Construction is required by Canton Municipal Utilities in order to extend a line and if such a Contribution-in-Aid-of-Construction is made by a prospective customer, the contribution will be considered a non-refundable cash requirement of Canton Municipal Utilities who will own, operate and maintain all facilities pertinent to the rendition of water service to the customer's property line and customer will have absolutely no ownership interest or other rights in such facilities. Service will be rendered according to the service rules and regulations of Canton Municipal Utilities, the appropriate rate schedule and any special agreements which have the proper approval of Canton Municipal Utilities and/or regulatory authorities.

The Contribution-in-Aid-of-Construction for developers of new residential developments is 100% of the actual cost for CMU to supply service to the development.

Such Contribution-in-Aid-of-Construction payments are due and payable in advance of any extension.

Upon termination of service, this deposit shall be refunded only if the customer's account is up to date with no balance due. In case of delinquency in payment for service and/or for damage or loss of property, CMU shall apply such a deposit to any amounts, and the customer will be refunded the balance, if any.</p> <p>For commercial customers only: A new or additional deposit may be required upon two weeks written notice of the need for such a requirement in cases where a deposit has been refunded or is found to be inadequate, or where a customer's credit standing is not satisfactory to CMU. Reconnection Fee

A fee for reconnection of water service will be applicable in case the water service is terminated for the reason of non-payment of fees for water service or where the termination is at the request of the customer, during his absence from the premises to which service is made. The fees for reconnection are as follows:

The fee for reconnection during CMU business hours is \$25.
The fee for reconnection outside CMU business hours is \$50.

Late Fee

Bills are due by the 18th of the month. A late charge penalty of \$5 will be added to bills after the 18th. Service will be cut off for non-payment on the 2nd Wednesday of next month if the temperature is higher than 32 degrees and lower than 100 degrees.

Charge for Returned Checks

Customers will be charged \$25 for returned checks.

Transfer Fee

Customers must pay \$25 to transfer service from one location to another.

RECOMMENDED ORDER APPROVING AMENDED FILING

THIS DAY, there came on for consideration before the Mississippi Public Service Commission (“the Commission”), the amended filing by Canton Municipal Utilities (“CMU”) seeking approval of monthly sewer rates, terms and conditions for the provision of sewer service in its Certificated Areas located in Madison County, Mississippi. Based upon the filing by CMU, as amended, the entire record of this matter and further based upon the recommendation of the Public Utilities Staff (“the Staff”), the Commission hereby finds, as follows:

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

1.

On November 29, 2016, CMU filed its Notice of Intent (“NOI”) seeking approval of monthly sewer rates, terms and conditions applicable to the residents located within its jurisdictional areas, which are located more than one-mile outside its corporate boundary. On June 1, 2017, CMU amended its NOI.

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FINDINGS & ORDER

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CMU is a public utility, as defined in Miss. Code Ann. § 77-3-3 (d)(iv), and is engaged in the business of providing sewer service, to the public for compensation, to its customer base

located more than one (1) mile outside its corporate boundaries and within its Commission-issued Certificated Areas located within Madison County, Mississippi.

CMU increased its monthly sewer rates effective October 1, 2012, for its jurisdictional customer base without first seeking approval from the Commission. This Commission has the exclusive original jurisdiction to determine just and reasonable rates applicable to the sewer service provided by CMU to its jurisdictional customer base. Moreover, a municipally owned or operated public utility cannot lawfully alter the rates it charges its customers, who reside more than one-mile outside its corporate boundaries, unilaterally. Instead, the Commission is the regulatory body with the legislative authority to set such rates and rate schedules. (Miss. Code Ann. §77-3-1; §77-3-5; §77-3-35; and §77-3-37).

The Commission, acting pursuant to the authority granted it by Miss. Code Ann. §77-3-41, allowed CMU on January 30, 2017, to temporarily amend its last Commission-approved sewer rate structure and tariff to mirror the rates it was actually charging its jurisdictional customer base.

After reviewing all supporting documentation presented by CMU in this Docket, the Commission concludes that it is in the public interest that CMU remain in a financial position so that it can continue to provide reasonably adequate sewer service to its jurisdictional customer base. The Commission finds it to be in the public interest that the temporary rates previously approved by it shall become permanent sewer rates, until changed by a subsequent Commission Order. The Commission expressly places CMU on notice that it must comply with the laws governing the regulation of public utilities. The Commission will not look kindly upon another failure to comply with all applicable law and places Canton on notice that a failure to follow such laws could result in a refund of monies collected. In this case, the Commission determines that the sewer rates, charges and service extension policy proposed by CMU represent fair, just and

reasonable rates. The Commission hereby approves CMU's amended NOI, along with its proposed tariff, marked hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein.

Issues surrounding responses by CMU provided during the investigation of this Docket, regarding certain monetary transfers of revenue generated from jurisdictional sewer rates, between CMU, the City of Canton ("Canton"), the Canton Redevelopment Authority and possibly others have resulted in a parallel Docket being created by the Commission, Docket 2019-AD-109, also known as the "Transfers Docket." The Commission takes administrative notice of this Docket. The Commission has bifurcated the issues of questionable transfers, as discussed above, into the Transfers Docket; therefore, the Commission expressly reserves its jurisdiction to issue all appropriate orders on all issues that may arise in the Transfers Docket.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, that the filing of CMU, as amended, is approved, along with the attached tariff, marked as Exhibit "A" hereto, which tariff reflects the applicable schedule of rates, terms and conditions for the rendition of sewer service, to the public for compensation, within CMU's Certificated Areas located in Madison County, Mississippi.

IT IS, FURTHER, ORDERED, that the Commission will address issues surrounding financial transfers between CMU and others in Docket 2019-AD-109, as discussed *supra*.

IT IS, FURTHER, ORDERED, that exceptions to this Recommended Order may be filed by the parties, within fifteen (15) days from the date of entry of this Recommended Order, for the review of the full Commission in accordance with Miss. Code Ann. § 77-3-40. If exceptions are not timely filed, this Recommended Order shall then become the Order of the Commission.

This Order shall be deemed issued on the date it is served upon the parties herein by the Executive Secretary of this Commission who shall note the service date in the file of this Docket.

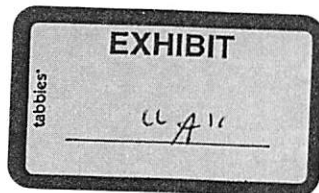
