**ORDER SETTING SALARY AND
APPOINTING STAFF ATTORNEY**

There having come on for consideration the matter of the apportionment of funds for the position of staff attorney for Judge James C. Walker, Chancellor for Place Three of the Eleventh Chancery Court District, it is hereby ordered by the undersigned Chancellor that \$52,100.00 shall be apportioned per year, plus benefits, for the position of Staff Attorney for Chancellor James C. Walker. Said salary is consistent with the AOC Trial Court Support Staff Salary Ranges. William Wilkerson is hereby appointed, effective February 17, 2020, to the position of Staff Attorney for Chancery Judge James C. Walker for the 11th Chancery Court District.


Effective February 17, 2020, the salary of said Staff Attorney shall be funded on a monthly basis first by application from the AOC support staff funds of Chancellor James C. Walker and then from the funds of the counties in the Eleventh Chancery Court District, to be prorated as follows:

Leake County	20%
Yazoo County	10%
