

By operating a food truck, or mobile food vendor at a designated area as approved by the Madison County Zoning Administrator, Owner/Operator agrees to the following terms and conditions:

1. Owner/Operator shall conduct activities in a safe and professional manner, and to comply with all Department, State and Federal rules and regulations including ADA requirements
2. Appropriate areas shall be accompanied with permission from landowners or Homeowner Association.
3. Any parking generated by the operation of such food trucks or mobile food vendor shall be met off the street.
4. A food truck or mobile food vendor shall not operate on the public roadway or in the public rights-of-way.
5. Owner/Operator shall comply with the Mississippi Department of Health guidelines.
6. Owner/Operator shall comply with other COVID-19 physical distancing:
 - a. all food truck or mobile food vendor workers to wear a mask and gloves at all times.
 - b. no self-service condiments.
 - c. signage and cones to promote physical distancing of customers.
 - d. online ordering and payment or touchless credit card payment, if possible.
 - e. texting of customer when order ready for pick-up to discourage lines.
7. Owner/Operator shall have all valid food permits and licenses from all the applicable local, county and/or state agencies and departments including Health Departments and have them present for inspection during the activity.
8. The maximum size for all food truck signs is two (2) square feet. Food truck signs shall be affixed to the vehicle no more than six (6) feet above floor level and may not be illuminated. This does not include the vehicle wraps, display boards of menu items and pricing.
9. Owner/Operator to provide all garbage receptacles and remove all garbage and receptacles at their own cost. This includes picking up litter associated with this activity.
10. All children must be accompanied by adults and supervised at all times.
11. No use of sound or voice amplification equipment.

Additional Guidance and Regulations

- Permits and fees associated with food trucks and mobile food vendors will be waived for a period of time set forth by the Madison County Board of Supervisors.
