Subject: Authorization for Madison County to bury unclaimed body

On May 24, 2020, Coroner Alex Breeland was called by Hospice Ministries 450 Towne Center Blvd, Ridgeland, MS for the death of Charles K. McBrayer. Mr. McBrayer had been admitted to Hospice Ministries on April 2, 2020. The primary caregiver who were listed for Mr. McBrayer are either deceased or are otherwise unreachable. His address prior to admission to Hospice Ministries was 139 Porter Street, Jackson, MS 39201. Mr. Breeland is requesting that Madison County provide burial for Mr. McBrayer as soon as possible.

I recommend that Mr. McBrayer body be buried in the county-owned cemetery located on George Washington Avenue in Canton, MS and that the board authorize payment of \$125.00 to F&M Transport for transportation of the body to the cemetery.
