MASIT member counties will formally elect six Trustees to serve on MASIT's fifteen-member Board of Trustees at the MASIT Annual Membership Meeting to be held at 10:00 am on Tuesday, August 11, 2020 during the MAS Annual Convention.

Each county will cast one ballot as a MASIT Member. In order to facilitate the voting process, we are circulating the attached ballot for your use as a Board in advance of the August 11 meeting. Meet and decide as a Board for whom your county will cast its votes. Your board may vote for up to six candidates. Ballots with votes for more than six candidates will be deemed invalid. Each Supervisor present when the Board makes its selections must sign the ballot, and a majority of the board must sign for the ballot to be official.

We will conduct the formal election by Member roll call at the Annual Membership Meeting on Tuesday, August 11, 2020. One designee from each Member will cast the ballot, unless the member has submitted its ballot *and* proxy to MAS before the August 3, 2020 deadline. The ballots will be tallied and results posted along with the outcome of the MAS Board, Officer and committee member elections outside of the MAS Honors Ceremony on Wednesday, August 12.
