Madison County EMPG Special Project #1 Outline

Madison County Emergency Management Agency would like to expand and upgrade our EOC/ Training Room at our facility. Our agency is in the process of installing a back up PSAP for our county at our facility. This equipment will be installed in the room we currently use as our "War Room" when we activate our EOC in response to a disaster or county event. Since this change was being made, we found it provided an ample opportunity to make some much-needed upgrades for our EOC. We are in the process of moving our EOC Room to the room we also use for training. This room will be dual purposed now and provide a more adequate space for our EOC as well.

In our revamp, our office has added dedicated wi-fi and copper lines to this room for this purpose. Purposed tables and furniture have been donated, reinventing the current working space. With adding the proposed technology outlined in this project, not only will it give our agency more efficient resources to respond, mitigate and train, this will also better serve any outside agencies and stakeholders engaged in response or training. Because of our current limited spacing and technology, it has proposed various challenges for our growing staff and having outside personnel and assistance in past events. This project will help us better carry out our duties in emergency management and enhance our mitigation, training, recovery, and response core capabilities.

It is our desire and goal to equip the revamped space with equipment that better enables our office to monitor and respond to emergency disasters and dually in training our first responders. Our proposed project consists of installing (2) 65" wall mounted smart TVs for monitoring multiple facets of an event and a smart board, which will also provide as a multi-use and working tool during an event. Also, included in the project proposal is a Surface Pro 7 tablet and a PA system. The dedicated tablet will be used for training opportunities, data entry (webEOC) in an event and as the gateway to monitor any needed facets. We have modeled this layout after various other EOC set ups in our neighboring counties, considering the best and most advantageous practices. The total cost for this project is \$5,933.80. Your consideration of our application will help in funding this project, offsetting the total expense.

The proposed equipment will remain stationary and dedicated to our EOC. Just as the rest of any equipment and machinery, weekly maintenance tests will be performed on all necessary equipment. All equipment is inventoried, and bi-yearly inventory checks are conducted in our agency.

Again, we thank you for the opportunity to apply for the EMPG Special Project Grant and for your consideration in helping Madison County better serve its citizens and first responders in their greatest times of need.
