ORDER FOR APPOINTMENT AND COMPENSATION OF COURT REPORTER


THERE HAVING COME on for consideration the matter of the appointment of an Official Court Reporter for the Eleventh Chancery Court District, it is hereby ordered by the undersigned Chancellor that, pursuant to *Miss. Code Ann.* §9-13-1 (Rev. 2014), Carrie McDill is hereby appointed Official Court Reporter for the undersigned Chancery Court Judge of the Eleventh Chancery Court District for a term of four years, effective January 1, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the annual salary for said Official Court Reporter is hereby set at \$64,000.00 per year, plus benefits, effective January 1, 2021, which is prorated between the counties in the District as follows:

ORDER SETTING SALARY OF STAFF ATTORNEY

There having come on for consideration the matter of the raise in salary of the staff attorney for the Senior Chancellor of the Eleventh Chancery Court District pursuant to the AOC Job Descriptions and Salary Ranges, it is hereby ordered by the undersigned Senior Chancellor that the salary of the staff attorney, Megan F. Mawhorter, is hereby set at \$65,500.00 per year, plus benefits effective January 1, 2021, pursuant to the AOC Trial Court Support Staff Salary Ranges for Staff Attorney - Level II. Said salary shall remain in effect until further order of this Court.

The salary of said Staff Attorney – Level II shall be funded on a monthly basis first by application from the AOC support staff funds of Senior Chancellor Cynthia L. Brewer and then from the funds of Madison County and Leake County prorated as follows:

Madison County: 80%

Leake County: 20%
