COMES NOW Petitioner, MAK, LLC, d/b/a Bridlewood of Madison, and files this, its Petition to Have Property Granted Qualified Resort Status, and shows unto the Madison County Board of Supervisors the following to-wit:

- 1. Petitioner, MAK, LLC, d/b/a Bridlewood of Madison, is a Mississippi limited liability company, whose address is 105 Woodlands Green Cove, Brandon, Mississippi, 39047. Petitioner is the owner of real property located in Madison County, Mississippi, located at 3024 Hwy. 22, Madison, Mississippi 39110, and being more particularly described in **Exhibit "1"** attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference. Petitioner operates as a special event venue and proposes to serve liquor and wine. The venue is known as Bridlewood of Madison.
- 2. Pursuant to Regulation 18 of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division of the Mississippi Department of Revenue, Petitioner shows that the area under consideration is located at 3024 Hwy. 22, Madison County, Madison, Mississippi 39110, and is shown on the map attached hereto as **Exhibit "2."** Said property should be classified as a Qualified Resort Area because this part of Madison County is a populated area which hosts numerous events organized by the community. This location is near several recreational facilities such as, Reunion Golf and Country Club, Lake Caroline Golf Club, Whisper Lake Country Club, and Annandale Golf Club. Bridlewood of Madison is one of Madison County's first event venue, hosting numerous celebrations such as, wedding ceremonies and receptions, rehearsal dinners, birthday parties, class reunions, and many corporate events. It is also located on 24.88 acres of land with on-site accommodations.

- 3. Assurance has been given by the Madison County Sheriff, Randall Tucker, that the local Alcoholic Beverage Control laws of the State of Mississippi, and Rules and Regulations of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission in said area will be enforced as shown by **Exhibit "3."**
 - 4. That Letters from three civic clubs are attached hereto as composite **Exhibit "4"**.
- 5. Legal Notices of the Application to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division shall be published once per week for two consecutive weeks in the **Madison County Herald.**

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Petitioner prays that this Petition be filed with the Board of Supervisors of Madison County, Mississippi, and that Petitioner be allowed to present this Petition to the Madison County Board of Supervisors at its next regular meeting, and that upon a hearing, the Madison County Board of Supervisors will approve Petitioner's request, cause its approval to be entered in the official minute book of the Madison County Board of Supervisors, and that the President of the Board, by letter, will make application with the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division of the Mississippi Department of Revenue, for its approval to grant qualified resort status to the property shown on Exhibit "2" and described on Exhibit "1."

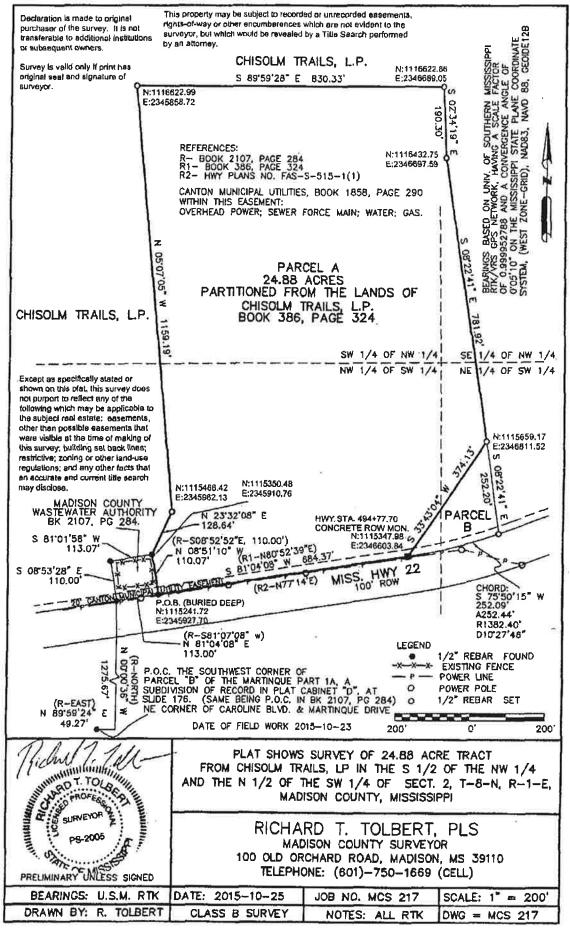

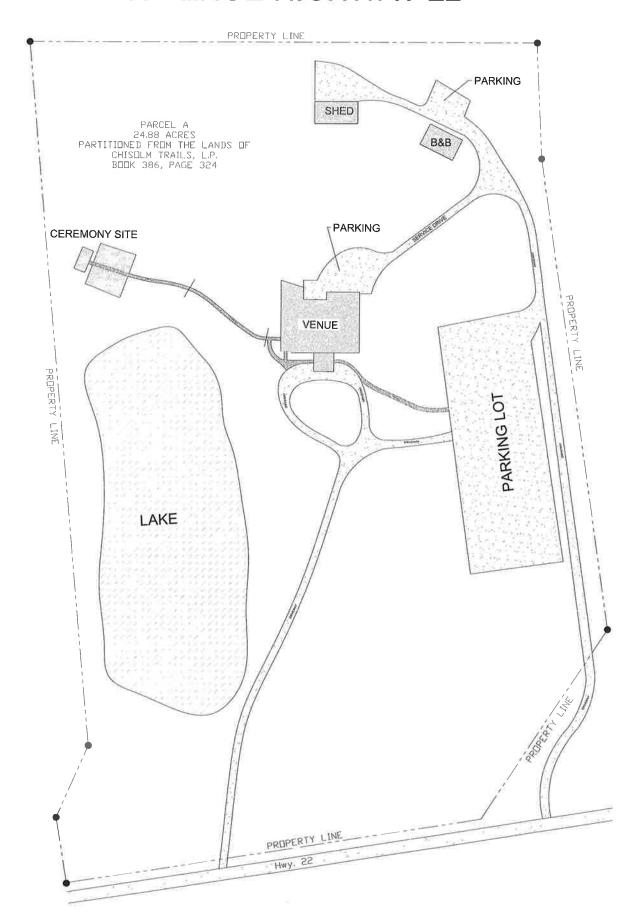
