
This responds to your July 29, 2021, request for information regarding the status of your group tax exemption.

Our records indicate that you were issued a determination letter in March 1946, that you are currently exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and are not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code because you are described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i).

Your request indicated that each subordinate organization is a non-profit organization, that no part of the net earnings thereof inures to the benefit of any individual, and that no substantial part of their activities is for promotion of legislation. You have further represented that none of your subordinate organizations is a private foundation under section 509(a), although all subordinates do not all share the same sub-classification under section 509(a). Based on your representations, the subordinate organizations in the *Official Catholic Directory for 2021* are recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Code under GEN 0928.

Donors may deduct contributions to you and your subordinate organizations as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to them or for their use are deductible for federal estate and gifts tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of section 2055, 2106, and 2522 of the Code.





The Charter of Incorporation of The Catholic Diocese of Natchez.

Section 1. Right Reverend Thomas heslin, the present Bishop of Natchez, Very reverend Patrick C Hayden, the present Vicar enral of Natchez, and Very reverend J L Wise, Very Reverend B J Bekkers, Very Reverend Alphonse Ketels, the present consulters of the said Thomas heslin, be and they are hereby incorporated as a body cor orate under the cor orate name

of the Catholic Diocese of Natchez for a period of fufty years with its domicile at Natchez, Miss. Section 2. The object and purpose of this act of incorporation is to enable said corporation to hold in trust the titles to the property, real and personal belonging to the several Catholic congregations, parishes and missions in the State of Mississippi, and to sell and convey the same in the marmer and upon the conditions hereinafter defined.

Section 3. Said corporation is hereby authorized and empowered to receive and to hold the titles to all of the property, real and personal belonging to the several Catholic congregations, parishes and hi sions in the state of Mississippi, in trust for the said congregations, parishes and missions respectively, and to that end may receive from Right Reverend Thomas Heslin the title by deed of conveyance to all of said property now held by him in trust for said congretaions, parishes and mis-

Section 4: The said congretaion is hereby authorized and empowered to receive and hold the title to any property hereafter acquired by any of the several congregations, parishes and missions in trust for the said congretaions, parishes and missons.

Section 5. Said corporation is ereby authorized and empowered to lease, mortgage or to sell and to deal with any property of said several congregations, parishes and missons In the manner and upon the conditions prescribed by the regulations of the Catholic Diocese of Natchez in Mississippi, relating to sha governing tapower and authority of the Bishop of Natchez in respect to conveyance by him, by lease, mortga e or sale of said property:

Section 6: All leases, deeds of conveyance and mortgages and other contracts respecting sadd property, both real and personal, are to be made in the corporate name of this corporation and are to be signed by the Bishop of Natchez, as the chief officer of the corporation and attested by the seal of the corporations

Section 7: Said corporation is to have a corporate seal of such style and design as may be selected by the incorporators and the same will be used in the maizhinamma attentation of all contracts. that are made and corporate acts that are done by said corporation, and that are usually attested by corporations by their seals.

Section 8: The Right Reverend Thomas heslin is hereby named as the chief officer of this corporation and very reverend Patrick C. hayden is hereby made the secretary of said corporation, and the four consultors are hereby made as they are at present, the consultors and advisors of the C ief. officer of the corroration.

Upon th dank or removal of the present Bishop of Natchez his successors as Bishop shall become inso facto his successors as chief official of the corporation, and so on during the life of this corporation, and upon the death or removal of the present Vicar General of Natchez, his successors as Vicar General shill succeed him as secretary of the corporation and so on during the life of this corporation. And in like manner the successors respectively of the four consultors herein named, shall succed them as consultors in this corporation during the life of this corporation. Section 9. No lease, sale, or mortgage can be made of any of said property except upon the appro-

val and decision of the Bishop, the chief officer of the corporation. Section 10. A book shall be kept by the Secretary in which all of the conveyances and contracts of the corporation shall be noted.

Section 11. It is esxpressly provided t at at the expiration of the period named in this charter the same may be renewed in the mode and manner provided by Section 834 of the Code of 1892 by the publication of the charter and application to the Governor of the State.

This charter shall go into effect from the date of its approval by the Governor of the State and shall continue for fifty years from its date.

The foregoing proposed charter of incorporation is respectfully referred to the Honorable Attorney General for his advice as to the constitutionality and le ality of the provisions thereof.
