



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING REGARDING A LAND PURCHASE TRANSACTION BETWEEN THE MADISON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND THE MINNIE J. BOZEMAN FAMILY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

This Memorandum of Understanding, (hereinafter the "Agreement") is made by and among the Madison County Board of Supervisors, a body politic (hereinafter referred to as "Madison County"), and the Minnie J. Bozeman Family Limited Partnership, a Mississippi limited partnership (hereinafter referred to as "the Partnership").

WHEREAS, Madison County is in the process of acquiring lands for the purpose of developing, constructing, and otherwise implementing a road and bridge project known as "the Reunion Bridge project", intended to complete an infrastructure road project, currently underway, and known as "Reunion Parkway project", which originates at State Highway 463, and travels easterly to Bozeman Road, crosses over U.S. Interstate 55, and intersects Parkway East Boulevard, and terminates at U.S. Highway 51, in Madison County, Mississippi, and;

WHEREAS, said roadway has been designated as "Reunion Parkway" and has been developed in the best interests of the citizens of Madison County, with intended

purpose to relieve traffic congestion in middle and north Madison County, and further to benefit the future transportation needs of the traveling public, at large; and

WHEREAS, at the initiation of the Reunion Parkway Project, the Partnership owned approximately four hundred (400) acres of property in Madison County, lying adjacent to the planned Reunion Parkway; and

WHEREAS, said Reunion Parkway project includes a proposed interchange which connects Interstate-55 with Reunion Parkway, via on-off ramps, constructed on both the east-west sides of the interstate highway, allowing the traveling public to traverse Reunion Parkway in both easterly-westerly directions; and

WHEREAS, the Reunion Parkway project, as contemplated and planned by the parties, traverses portions of the Partnership property, the Partnership has previously granted, through both sale and donation, certain right of way easements for the benefit of Madison County, and the Partnership appreciates that more property remains in need of acquisition by Madison County, in fee simple, in order that both parties can accomplish the benefit that will be mutually derived by completion of the Reunion Parkway project; and that said ownership of the property will enable Madison County to comply with Mississippi Department of Transportation's (MDOT) policies, and will allow county to petition for substantial assistance from MDOT and other relevant state and federal agencies; and

WHEREAS, PREMISES CONSIDERED, and in furtherance of the project and in consideration of the commitments of Madison County and the Partnership, respectively, set forth more fully herein, and parties respectively agree to the terms

and conditions expressed herein, and upon and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Madison County has established the location of the proposed interchange on I-55 as it relates to the Reunion road and bridge project, and Madison County has agreed to seek and to obtain all necessary assistance and regulatory permits from MDOT to successfully complete the Reunion road and bridge project.
- 2. The parties hereto agree that immediately upon tendering of a Special Warranty Deed, conveying ownership of 35.0743 acres of property, in fee simple, said property being described more particularly as set forth as Exhibit "A" herein, the Madison County Board of Supervisors will pay to owner, the Minnie J. Bözeman Family Limited Partnership, the sum of Nine Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$965,000.00) as consideration.
- 3. The parties hereto agree that the Partnership, its successor and assigns will donate to Madison County Board of Supervisors, the remaining value of said acreage (\$1,403,000.00), according to the certified appraisal (Transmittal Letter) as set forth herein as Exhibit "B" attached hereto, the same being incorporated by reference.
- 4. The parties understand and agree that the values outlined in section (3) hereinabove, constitutes donatory consideration by Partnership in favor of Madison County to enable it to proceed more efficiently and expeditiously with initiation and completion of the Reunion Parkway and bridge project interchange at the US. Interstate-55 location.

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5. The parties hereto agree that the Partnership, its successors or assigns will allow reasonable and temporary access to right-of-way adjacent to acreage being

obtained under this Agreement, if any are needed, to facilitate construction (construction easements) regarding the Reunion bridge and road project.

- The parties agree that upon ninety-days (90 days), after which the interchange at U.S. Interstate-55, at Reunion Parkway, shall have been completed, and certified for use by MDOT as a certified load bearing roadway for vehicular traffic, the Partnership shall tender and pay to Madison County the sum of Nine Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$965,000.00), representing full refund of the amount previously tendered to Partnership by Madison County. It is mutually understood by parties that the practical effect of said reimbursement to Madison County, is such that the Partnership would have then donated One Hundred Percent (100%) of the value of said Partnership lands to Madison County for the purpose of completing the Reunion road and bridge project with the MDOT approved interchanges:
- 7. Within 60 days of the filing of the Special Warranty Deed in this matter, the parties agree that Madison County shall provide to McMaster & Associates, agent of Seller, a map depicting the roadway elevation levels of the proposed Reunion Parkway areas west of U.S. I-55.
- 8. Within 30 days of the filing of the Special Warranty Deed in this matter Madison County shall direct its engineer to mark the right-of-way for the convenience of Seller.
- 9. Madison County agrees to cooperate with Seller to provide all documentation necessary to achieve federal and state charitable credits due to Seller pursuant to this transaction, as well as the future donation envisioned after completion of the construction of the interchanges to I-55.

10. It is understood that all previous Agreements, Memoranda of Understanding(s), or Addendum(s) to any MOU's between the parties are hereby null and void, and any deeds currently on file with the Madison County Chancery Clerk between the Partnership and Madison County for the 35.0743 acres of property will be revoked, rendering it a nullity, in favor of a new Special Warranty Deed in favor of Madison County, that shall be signed, and executed by both parties, and filed in the land records of Madison County Chancery Clerk's Office, with this Agreement being affixed thereto as Exhibit "B", along with the official Minutes of the Madison County Board of Supervisors when the board shall have acknowledged such Agreement.

- 11. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to indicate or represent that this Agreement is "time-limited" as to construction of the interchange at I-55, or that this Agreement is subject to rescission, revocation, or can be returned to ownership of Partnership, by operation of law, upon any failure of Madison County to achieve permit of MDOT to construct the proposed interchange.
- 12. This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, and their respective heirs successors and assigns.
- 13. The laws of the State of Mississippi shall govern this Agreement. If it becomes necessary to ensure the performance of the conditions of this Agreement to employ an attorney and incur legal expenses of litigation, then the defaulting party shall pay reasonable attorney fees and court costs therewith. Venue for any legal action arising hereunder or between the parties as it relates to the terms of this Agreement shall be Madison County, Mississippi.

14. The Partnership hereby waives property rights in accordance with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, Public Law 91-646, and 49 CFR Part 24, Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition for Federal and Federally Assisted Programs, and all additional rights and privileges under the "Relocation Assistance Law" and Sections 43-37-1, et seq., and Sections 43-39-1, et seq. of the Mississippi Code of 1972 (Annotated).

WHEREFORE, the parties hereto have executed this Agreement as of the date of Final approval by the Madison County Board of Supervisors, with signature affixed hereto by the President of the Board of Supervisors, and also upon the tendering, execution, and filing of a Special Warranty Deed in favor of Madison County Board of Supervisors. Execution of this Agreement in multiple counterparts will serve to make this Agreement binding upon the parties.
