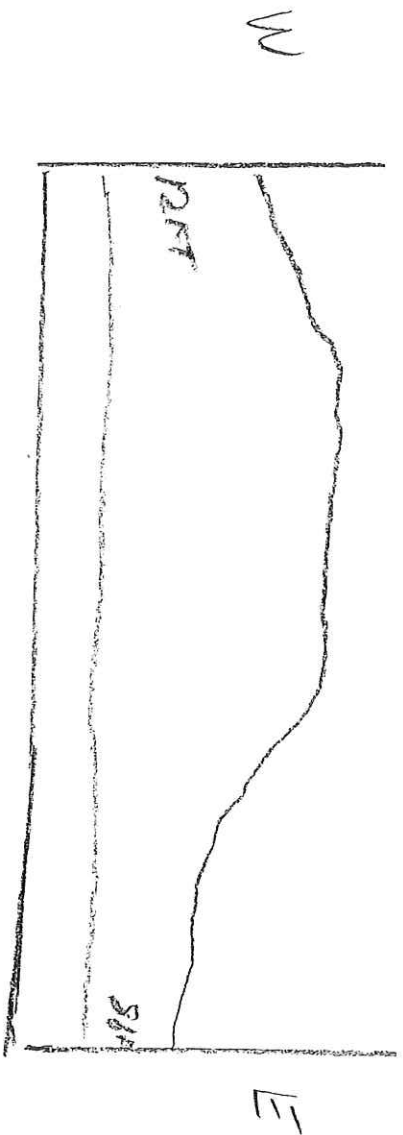
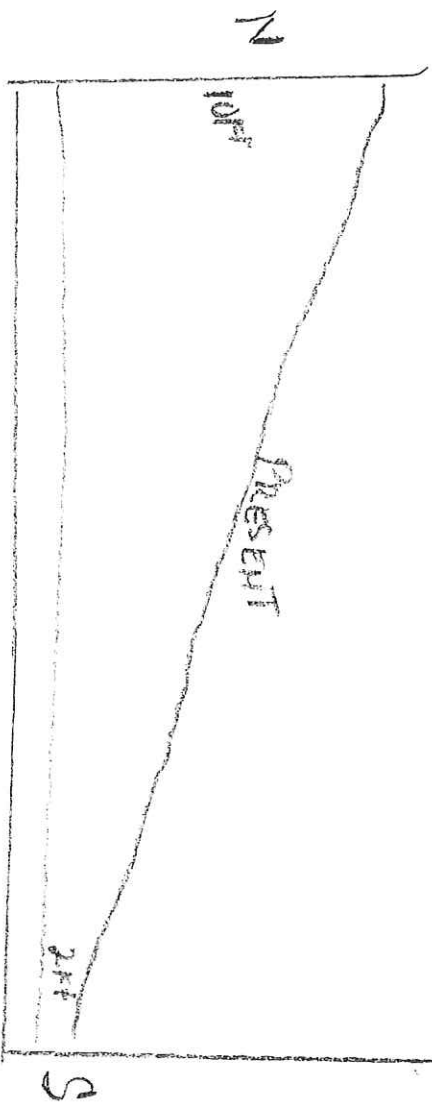
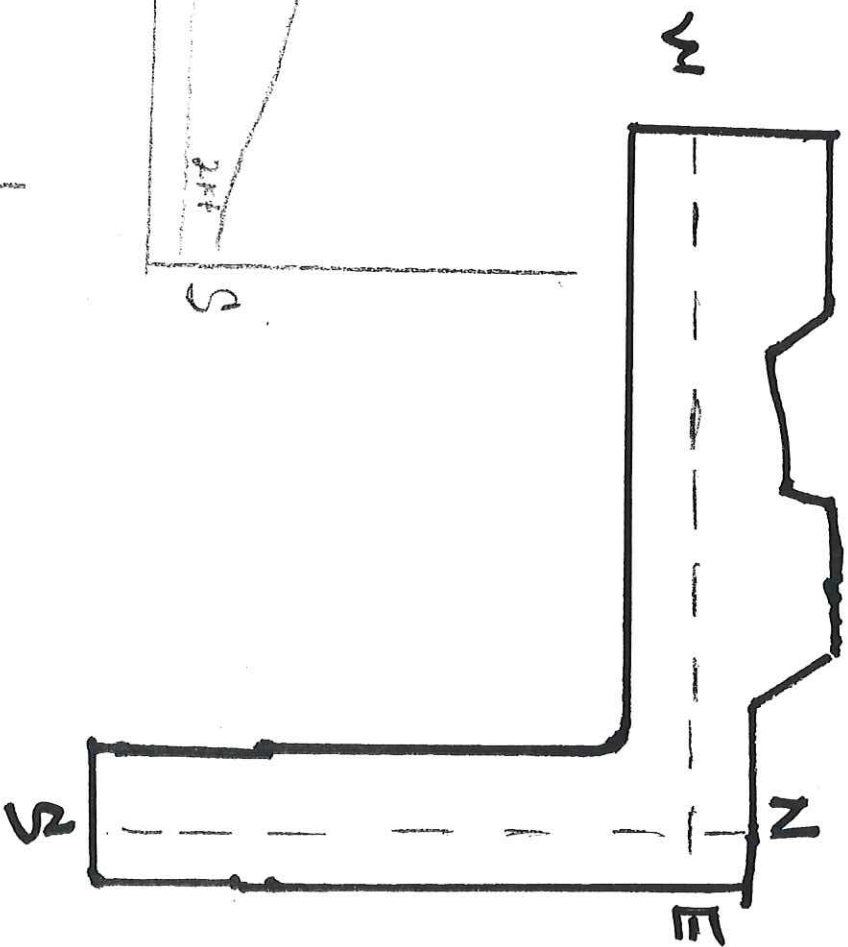
MAP # 2

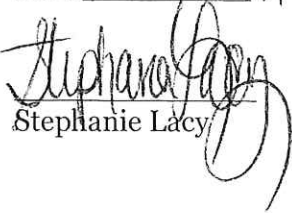

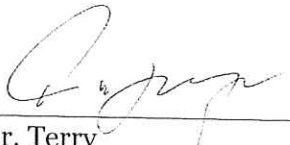
