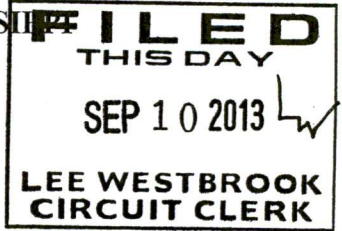

ORDER ESTABLISHING COURT TERMS

PURSUANT to the provisions of Miss. Code Ann. §9-7-3(2)(as amended),

**IT IS ORDERED** that the regular terms of Circuit Court in Madison and Rankin counties of the Twentieth Circuit Court District for the year 2014 are established as follows, with the first day of each term designated as Motion Day:

- (1) On the first Monday in January for twenty four (24) days.
- (2) On the first Monday in February for thirty (30) days.
- (3) On the second Monday in March for thirty (30) days.
- (4) On the second Monday in April for thirty (30) days.
- (5) On the third Monday in May for thirty (30) days.
- (6) On the fourth Monday in June for thirty (30) days.
- (7) On the fourth Monday in July for thirty (30) days.
- (8) On the first Tuesday in September for twenty nine (29) days.
- (9) On the first Monday in October for thirty (30) days.
- (10) On the second Monday in November for thirty (30) days.
- (11) On the third Monday in December for six (6) days.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that a certified copy of this order shall be (1) posted in the Office of the Circuit Clerk of Madison and Rankin counties (2) delivered to the clerk of the Board of Supervisors of Madison and Rankin counties and (3) mailed to the Mississippi Secretary of State for publication and distribution as provided by law.
