It was thought that Mr. Mabon was a veteran and would qualify for burial in the veteran cemetery, however he did not qualify. Coroner Alex Breeland is requesting that Madison County provide burial for Mr. Mabon as soon as possible.

I recommend that Mr. Mabon's body be buried in the county-owned cemetery located on George Washington Avenue in Canton, MS and that the board authorize payment of \$125.00 to F&M Transport for transportation of the body to the cemetery.
