Coroner Alex Breeland is requesting that Madison County provide burial for Mr. Mabon as soon as possible.

I recommend that Mr. Mabon's body be buried in the county-owned cemetery located on George Washington Avenue in Canton, MS and that the board authorize payment of \$125.00 to F&M Transport for transportation of the body to the cemetery.
