Attachment to Articles of Incorporation of St. Matthews United Methodist Church, Inc.


- 8. <u>Purpose</u>. This nonprofit corporation is established as a religious corporation. It is organized as a local United Methodist Church exclusively for religious purposes, supporting the doctrine of The United Methodist Church, and declares itself and all of its properties subject to the law, usages, and ministerial appointments of the United Methodist Church.
- Operations. This nonprofit corporation is to be operated exclusively for charitable, 9. religious, and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. No part of the earnings of the nonprofit corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the nonprofit corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the exempt purposes set forth above. No substantial part of activities of the nonprofit corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The nonprofit corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of its Articles of Incorporation, the nonprofit corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
- 10. <u>Members</u>. The nonprofit corporation will have members. Upon filing these Articles of Incorporation, the members of the former unincorporated local United Methodist Church shall be members of the nonprofit corporation. Only those members of the nonprofit corporation who are members of the Charge Conference as defined in The Book of Discipline of The United Methodist Church ("the Discipline") as applicable to local churches, are entitled to vote at a meeting of the members; provided, however, if the District Superintendent convenes a Charge Conference as a Church Conference, all members of the nonprofit corporation shall be entitled to vote.
- 11. <u>Powers</u>. The business of this nonprofit corporation shall be conducted in conformity with the Discipline as it now exists or as it may hereafter be amended, changed or modified. The Bylaws of the nonprofit corporation shall include the Discipline, and no Bylaws shall be adopted inconsistent with the provisions of the Discipline.

In addition to the powers and duties granted to the nonprofit corporation by the Discipline, the nonprofit corporation assumes for itself all the rights, powers, and privileges and immunities which are now and which may during the existence thereof be conferred by

law upon a corporation with a similar character, provided with such rights, powers, and privileges, and immunities are not inconsistent with the Discipline. All amendments, bylaws, and regulations of this nonprofit corporation shall at all times be in conformity with the Discipline.

Notwithstanding the above, at no time shall any of the amendments, bylaws, or regulations of the nonprofit corporation be prohibited or in conflict with the nonprofit corporate laws of the State of Mississippi.

12. <u>Term.</u> This nonprofit corporation shall exist in perpetuity. If for any reason the nonprofit corporation shall be abandoned, discontinued, or cease to exist as a legal entity and/or its Articles of Incorporation shall expire or be terminated, title to all its property, both real and personal, shall be vested in and the property of the Mississippi Conference of the United Methodist Church, pursuant to the Discipline, provided it is then an organization qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code; and if not, to any other organization designated by such Annual Conference, which is then qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
