Per statutory guidelines set out in Miss. Code Ann.§25-3-35(6) (1972, as amended) and House Bill 1423, Ms. Allen will soon be eligible for a pay increase as she will have been licensed to practice law for at least 15 years or more since she was admitted to the Mississippi Bar on May 03, 2008. Ms. Allen's salary is currently \$114,240/annually (plus an annual supplement in the amount of \$6,000), however, effective May 03, 2023, she should statutorily earn the sum of \$120,960/annually, plus her \$6,000.00 supplement. The necessary Personnel Recommendation is attached hereto.

Please make Ms. Allen's annual pay increase effective May 03, 2023. Our office will reimburse Madison County for Ms. Allen's statutory salary increase should the Board decline to pay for same (the BOS is currently funding both her annual salary and supplement.)
