
## **Reunion Crossing Phase 2**



Reunion Crossing Phase 2 is a \$34.5 million total project with an estimated \$29.5 million construction budget. It will connect Bozeman Road with Parkway East and include a bridge over Interstate 55. The improvements will aid in the proposed interstate access via ramps constructed by MDOT at the time I-55 is widened. The county expects to advertise for construction of the project by the end of May 2023. Once the project is awarded, construction for the bridge, excluding the ramps to I-55, is expected to take 24 months. The beginning of the construction will overlap with a \$2.4 million 30-inch water main relocation which will




conclude by January 1, 2024. The final right-of-way purchases for the ramps will be completed by the County before April 30, 2023.

The County has utilized its own funds, appropriations from our federal partners, and the State has graciously allocated \$19 million to this project. Despite this exceedingly generous allocation, the county's remaining share of the project, barring any additional funding from state or federal sources, is \$11.1 million.



Reunion Crossing Phase 3 is a \$27.7 million total project with a construction budget of \$22.7 million. It will run from Parkway East to Highway 51, giving Madison County residents an additional east-west corridor parallel to Highway 463, near Gluckstadt, and North of the City of Madison. Construction of the project has been awarded to Hemphill Construction and should begin in May of this year Construction is expected to be completed by May 31, 2025.

The county has used its own funds, received \$4.4 million in MPO funds, and received \$7 million from the Federal Omnibus bill. Currently, the county's remaining cost is expected to be \$13.3 million.




## **Bozeman Road Phase 1**




Bozeman Road Phase 1 is a \$32 million total project with an estimated construction budget of \$25 million. It will widen the existing Bozeman Road from Reunion Parkway south to Highway 463 and add a multiuse trail from Highway 463 to Gluckstadt Road while upgrading the intersection of Bozeman Road at Gluckstadt Road to facilitate easier access to Bozeman Road. The County has purchased all the right-of-way for the project with the final utility relocation to be completed by the end of April 2023. Once the project is awarded, construction is expected to take 2.5 years.

Through a combination of state, federal, and county ARPA funds, the remaining unfunded expenses for Phase 1 total \$5.1 million.



## **Bozeman Road Phase 2**



Bozeman Road Phase 2 is an estimated \$16M project with a projected \$13M construction budget. It will widen Bozeman Road north from Reunion Parkway to Gluckstadt Road in the City of Gluckstadt. The County is finalizing design and should complete right-of-way purchases within the year. Some utilities will have to be moved depending on the final design, but the utility relocation should take less than a year. The County anticipates advertising for bids within 24-30 months.

The County has to date received no outside funding from state or federal partners, so the county's share of the construction is \$16 million.
