RE: Address Reassignments (Chantry Lane)

Due to the changes that have been made to the original plat and lots in Charleston, specifically on Chantry Lane, we are seeking approval to readdress the existing structures on Chantry Lane. There was a recent split of a lot which initiated an address assignment. Upon site visit, it was determined that there is only one available number with lots in between, therefore causing problems for future address assignments. Further discovered, the addresses that are existing are not all in alignment, which could potentially cause problems rendering emergency services. The addressing problems in this area are in part because of the numerous changes in the lots being split and plats being amended.

Although there are several areas in the Charleston subdivision that need attention, we are solely asking for the approval to readdress Chantry Lane at this time, due to the pending address request. At this time, the reassignment will constitute changing five existing structures and one structure under construction.

Upon approval and reassignment, our office will work with the residents to ensure they have proper paperwork to make the needed changes.
