The first phase will consist of 5 data center buildings, each approximately 215,000 square feet, plus an ancillary building related to site security and entry control. Section 501.02 D. of the zoning ordinance requires "One parking space for each 1,000 square feet of gross floor area, or one parking space for each employee on the largest shift, whichever is greater." This would require approximately four times the number of spaces necessary, based on Applicant's experience at other data center locations. The site will not be open to the public. Further, due to the size of the site, there is no possibility that any parking demand could impact any public roads near the site. The Applicant requests that a variance be granted to provide parking spaces based on the highest number of employees at each building as set out in Section 501.02 D., but without regard to the square footage of the building. Applicant intends to build some additional parking to accommodate shift changes and other situations, but this could vary by building and on groupings of buildings in future phases. Reducing the parking requirement will also result in less unnecessary impervious area and a more attractive site overall. This variance is requested for Applicant's entire "mega site" project site with respect to data center buildings and any ancillary buildings.
