The mission of the American Red Cross is to prevent and alleviate human suffering in the face of emergencies by mobilizing the power of volunteers and the generosity of donors. From January 1 to December 31, 2023, this American Red Cross chapter provided **\$28,584** in emergency financial assistance in **19** different home fire cases involving **99** individuals in Madison County. This assistance helped provide food, clothing, lodging, and medications in the aftermath of an emergency. Clients also received disaster-related health care, referrals to community partners and government resources, and other essential items that can be used immediately during recovery.

All American Red Cross disaster assistance and services are free, made possible by the generosity of donors like you. Assistance to your community is provided without regard to citizenship, race, religion, age, culture or creed.

In addition to the disaster services we provide, the American Red Cross touches the lives of the people in your area through our Services to the Armed Forces (SAF). In this past year, we provided **81** SAF case services to members of the military and their families in Madison County. We also provide Preparedness, Health, and Safety classes which make your area a safer place to live. This year, **591** individuals in Madison County took one of these courses from the Red Cross.

We request the Madison County Board of Supervisors consider supporting American Red Cross Disaster Services for residents of Madison County in the amount of **\$10,000** for the coming year.
