Good Afternoon Kesha,

Ultimately, it is up to the Board whether they want to consider this application, but there certainly can be requests that will be for personal property only when the business is renting/leasing real estate, but owns their business equipment. Business personal property is subject to ad valorem taxation so an exemption would need to be granted in order for the business to be exempt from these taxes.

NAMI has a personal property PPIN assigned in the current tax roll. If you would like to ask them to update their application to reference the PPIN, it is PPIN 13519, or you could ask them to add a note that this is for business personal property. The application does not specifically have a field to denote this.

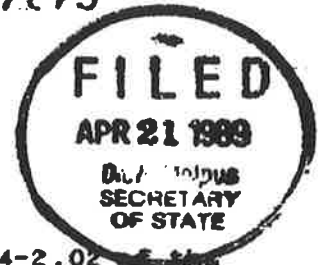

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Admendment Number 1

B. 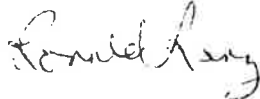

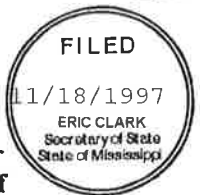
