

ORDER ALLOWING COMMISSION TO CIRCUIT CLERK

THIS CAUSE having come on upon the Motion Ore Tenus of the Circuit Clerk of Madison County, Mississippi, for the allowance of the commission due her under the provision of 25-7-13(5) et seq. of the Mississippi Code of 1972 as amended in the above styled cause and the Court having reviewed and considered this matter in light of the responsibility assumed by the Circuit Clerk as well as the services rendered by the Circuit Clerk finds that in this cause the Madison County Circuit Clerk should receive an amount equal to one-half of one percent commission on the monies coming in to her hands in the matter is **\$450,000.00** and that her commission is and should be **\$2,250.00**.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Madison County, Mississippi shall pay into the Circuit Clerk of Madison County, Mississippi the sum of **\$2,250.00** as her commission as clerk of the Special Court of Eminent Domain in the cause.
