

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF
ALDERMEN/ALDERWOMAN OF THE CITY OF CANTON, MISSISSIPPI,
MADISON COUNTY, FIXING THE MUNICIPAL AD VALOREM TAX
LEVY FOR THE YEAR OCTOBER 1, 2024 – SEPTEMBER 30, 2025**

Whereas, Section 21-33-45, Mississippi Code Annotated (1972) requires the fixing of the tax rate or levy for the municipal for the fiscal year next succeeding by September 15; and

Whereas, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderwoman as require to do have determined that the tax rate for the fiscal year 2024-2025.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the Mayor and Board of Aldermen/Alderwoman of Canton, Mississippi that the tax rate or levy shall be for the fiscal year next succeeding as follows:

General Fund: 47.92
Debt Service: 15.23
Library: 1.25
Total City Millage: 64.40

School District Operations 41.03
School Debt Services 11.25
Total School Millage: 52.28

Total Levy City and School 116.68

SECTION 1: For the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2024, there shall be and there is hereby levied on all taxable property, real and personal, within the corporate limits of the City of Canton, Mississippi, for ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes, the following levy to be collected upon each dollar of assessed value as shown upon the real and personal ad valorem assessment rolls of said City of Canton, Mississippi, as to such property within the corporate limits, to-wit:

For general purposes and for general improvements: 64.4 mills

SECTION 2: That the Tax Collector of Madison County, Mississippi, be and hereby is authorized and directed to collect said taxes for the City of Canton, Mississippi.

SECTION 3: The Clerk of this Board be and is hereby ordered to print this resolution and have a copy of this resolution posted in its entirety in three public locations within the municipality, including at City Hall, within ten days after this date, and to certify a copy of this resolution to the Tax Collector of Madison County, Mississippi, and to the State Tax Commission, as required by section 21-33-47, Mississippi State Code of 1972, Annotated.

SECTION 4: This resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage. UPON THE MOTION OF Alderperson Wales, duly seconded by Alderperson Taylor, the aforesaid resolution was put to a vote with the voting as follows:
