LABOR RATES AND PAYMENT TERMS:

Normal working hours: 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday

Overtime working hours: 5:01 PM to 7:59 AM, Monday through Friday and Weekends and Holidays.

There will be a one (1) hour minimum on regular time and overtime service calls during the week and a two (2) hour minimum on weekends and holidays.

Service calls not covered under the Service Agreement Proposal will be billed at current rates. Time starts and stops at our facility. Currently our rates are as follows:

RENEWAL:

This Agreement can be automatically renewed at the end of the term and is subject to price adjustment in accordance with paragraph below unless either party gives the other written notice to the contrary at least thirty (30) days prior to the end of the contract year. Neither party shall be liable in any manner to the other on account of such termination. This quotation is subject to acceptance within thirty days from date of Agreement. Pricing is then subject to review. Any increase/decrease in pricing of the signed Agreement must be submitted forty-five (45) days prior to Agreement's renewal date,

AGREEMENT PRICING, TERM, AND ACCEPTANCE:

The price for this Support Services Agreement Proposal is \$69,020 per year and is payable in the amount of \$5751.67 per month, plus any applicable. tax, net thirty days.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Terms and Conditions:

- A) Pricing and Payment Terms: Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this proposal, the amounts provided in this proposal are estimates only, and invoices will be based on the actual products delivered and work performed, as determined by Company, which may be more or less than the estimates provided. Pricing estimates do not include any applicable sales taxes. Interim invoices and/or a final invoice may be provided during the course of the project and/or upon completion of the project. Each invoice, whether an interim invoice delivered during the course of the project or a final invoice delivered after completion of the project, shall be paid within 30 days after receipt by the Customer.
- Payment Default: Interest at a rate of 1% per month from the date due until payment is received in full shall be applied to all unpaid amounts. In the event any payment is not received by Company when due, Company shall have all rights and remedies available hereunder, at law, or in equity, including, without limitation, and without exclusivity, the right to (i) cease work on the project, (ii) terminate its obligation to complete the project, (iii) require advance payment or other security from the Customer, and/or (iv) institute a formal legal proceeding against the Customer. If Company terminates its obligation to complete the project, Company shall be relieved from all obligations and liabilities to the Customer under this proposal and otherwise related to the project, but the Customer shall remain liable for all amounts owed to Company for all products provided and work performed up to the date of such termination and for all other fees and costs due hereunder. The Customer shall also be liable for all costs, expenses, and fees (including court costs and reasonable attorneys' fees) incurred by Company as a result of such non-payment by the Customer and in collecting payment from the Customer.
- C) Change Orders: Upon request of Company, any material deviation from the Scope of Project as stated above shall be set forth in writing and signed by both Company and the Customer.
- D) Choice of Law; Venue. The provisions of this proposal shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Mississippi, without regard to any conflicts of laws policies or principles. Venue for any dispute related to this Proposal shall be in the state courts of Rankin County, Mississippi, or, if applicable, the federal court of the district of which such county is a part.
- E) Severability: If any part of this Proposal is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other part hereof or the proposal as a whole.
- F) Integration: This proposal embodies the entire agreement and understanding between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof, and supersedes any prior statements, understandings, or agreements, whether verbal or written, with respect to the subject matter hereof, all of which have no effect.
- G) Attorneys' Fees: In the event of any formal legal proceeding regarding this proposal or the transactions contemplated hereby, the substantially prevailing party in such proceeding shall be entitled to recover all reasonable attorneys' fees and other legal costs that such party incurs therein; provided, however, that such recovery shall not diminish or otherwise affect any other relief or remedy to which such party is entitled.
- H) Force Majeure: If any party is unable to perform its non-monetary obligations under this proposal as a result of natural disaster, acts of third parties, or other causes or conditions beyond the reasonable control of such Party, such party shall be temporarily relieved of his obligation to so perform.
- Timing: Company will endeavor to complete the Project within the time frame estimated above but shall not be responsible for delays or its failure to complete the project due to causes outside of Company's reasonable control, whether related to this specific project or to Company or the Customer generally, including, without limitation, weather conditions, fire or other casualty, product or equipment availability, or labor disputes.
- J) The Customer shall provide Company with all information in the Customer's possession or control that may be necessary or relevant to the completion of the scope of work described above.
- K) Liability: Company shall not be responsible for, and the Customer agrees to release, indemnify against, and hold Company harmless from, any claim, loss, or liability resulting from or related to (i) any underground utilities or other items in the area of the project, (ii) any unforeseen conditions, and (iii) any lack of relevant information known by the Customer.

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
