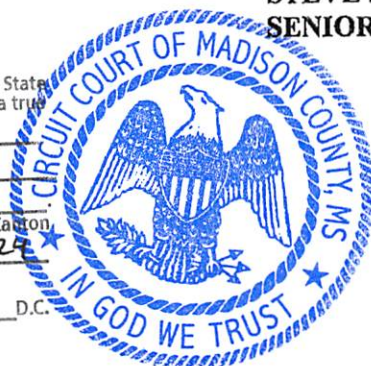
**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, pursuant to the provisions of Miss. Code Ann. §9-7 3(2) (1972, as amended), the regular terms of the Circuit Court in Madison and Rankin Counties of the Twentieth Circuit Court District for the year 2025 are established as follows:

- (1) On the second Monday of January for six (6) weeks.
- (2) On the third Tuesday of February for six (6) weeks.
- (3) On the fifth Monday of March for six (6) weeks.
- (4) On the second Monday of May for six (6) weeks.
- (5) On the fourth Monday of June for eight (8) weeks.
- (6) On the third Monday of August for six (6) weeks.
- (7) On the fifth Monday of September for six (6) weeks.
- (8) On the second Monday of November for eight (8) weeks.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that a certified copy of this order shall be (1) **Posted in the Office of the Circuit Clerk of each county** (2) **delivered to the clerk of the Board of Supervisors of each county** and (3) **mailed to the Secretary of State for publication and distribution as provided by law.**
