

Traffic Engineering

(1) See attached comments on signing and marking.

(2) Recommend that the applicant conduct a traffic study to determine if turn lanes

and/or signal on US 51 will be warranted.

(3) They need to show the entire intersection (both sides of US 51) in the permit plan to make sure that everything is lined up properly. Sowell Rd. is skewed and we don't want them to build a misaligned intersection.

Roadway Design

(1) Sheet 1/18

• It appears the typical section in the top right corner doesn't apply to US

• For bottom left typical section:

(1) Cut fore slope should be placed on a 4:1 with a 3' ditch. In fill sections, the fore slope should be 4:1 within the clear zone and 3:1 beyond.

(2) The entire width of US 51 should be overlaid within the limits of construction.



- (3) Need to see traffic control plans for coordinating the 12" of lime treated sub grade. Normally the attached shoulder drop-off sheet would address this situation, but it may be difficult to treat 12" for any appreciable length and get it covered up before the construction day is over.
- (4) A left turn lane should be placed along US 51 for traffic turning onto Sowell Rd.
- (2) Sheet 2/8- Curb and gutter should be type 2 rather than 3b. Eastbound traffic flow arrow at US 51/Sowell Rd. intersection should be modified for left only and not a thru movement.
- (3) Sheet 3/8 Curb and gutter for channelization islands and turn legs should be Type 2.
- (4) Sheet 4/8 Reference is made concerning temporary construction easements along US 51. Additional right of way along US 51 should be purchased if construction limits extend beyond existing rather than setting up temporary construction easements.
- (5) Sheet 9/18 Modify striping for Sowell Rd. as it approaches US 51. There is currently a left and a thru. There should only be a left turn arrow and the rest should be stripped out until the future construction east of 51 is completed.
- (6) Sheet 10/18 The Road Work 1500, 1000, and 500 signs can be omitted and replaced with a Road Work 1 mile sign. At the beginning of the work zone, add Road Work Next 1 mile and place on type 3 barricade (double faced 6' wide). Opposite this sign will be an end road work sign on the same barricade. The barricade for the turn legs should be a minimum of 16' wide. If the determination is made that the 12" lime treatment of the sub grade will require pre-cast concrete barrier, then a detailed traffic control plan will be necessary.
