Levi Strauss & Co. is permanently closing its entire distribution center located at 501 Denim Way, Canton, MS 39046 ("Canton Site"). As a result, employment separations are expected to begin as follows: For our union-represented population, separations will begin on or about December 20, 2024, or during the 14-day period beginning on that date. For our home office population, separations will begin on or about January 10, 2025, or during the 14-day period beginning on that date.

Approximately 267 employees are anticipated to lose employment as a result of the closure. Some of the affected employees are represented by Workers United Local 2550 and its international union. As a result, notice of the closure is being provided to Lynne Fox, International President Workers United, an SEIU affiliate, via Email only as requested; Chris Baumann, Regional Director, Workers United Southern Region, an SEIU affiliate via Email only as requested; Rockmon Allan, Canton Site President, Workers United Southern Region via Email and U.S. mail.

Bumping rights for Workers United-represented employees are governed by applicable labor agreements. Bumping rights are not available for unrepresented employees.
