**THEREFORE**, under the powers vested in me by the Madison County Board of Supervisors and Miss. Code Ann. §31-7-1 et seq., I, Greg Higginbotham, County Administrator and Madison County Board of Supervisors' officially named designee, do hereby declare an emergency exists concerning the safety and welfare of Madison County employees. This declaration shall only be applicable to expenses incurred by the Madison County Sheriff's Office and the Madison County Board of Supervisors related to electrical issues impacting the exhaust fans.
