SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR SAFE STREETS ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) IMPLEMENTATION GRANT APPLICATION FOR MADISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) has published a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) ON March 28, 2025, to apply for a 2025 discretionary grant funding through the Safe Streets Roads for All (SS4A).

WHEREAS the Madison County Board of Supervisors would like to apply for a 2025 SS4A Implementation Grant to provide funding to reconstruct the intersection of US Highway 51 and Yandell Road/Weisenberger Road to minimize accidents within the project area.

WHEREAS the Madison County Board of Supervisors desires to apply for 80% from SS4A Implementation Grant with the local share of a minimum 20% of the cost of the project. The anticipated project cost \$5,750,000 with a local share of \$1,150,000 and federal grant of \$4,800,000 under the SS4A grant program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED by the Madison County Board of Supervisors that: President Gerald Steen is authorized to execute all necessary documents to support the completion of the SS4A grant application process.
