It further appearing that section 19-13-31 MS Code of 1972 (Annotated) authorizes the Court to order that payment be made to the vendor for products and services delivered to the county in the absence of a purchase order and other similar documentation; and It further appearing that Stribling Equipment LLC, vendor in this matter, has agreed to the

substance of this Complaint, has entered its Joinder to this Application and Complaint, has waived service of process through its authorized representative, and has agreed to the Form of the Order in this matter, and the Court having jurisdiction of the subject matter and of the parties is of the opinion that the claims should be paid.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED that the Madison County Board of Supervisors be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and ordered to pay the invoices and claims of Stribling Equipment LLC, vendor in this matter, in the aggregate amount of \$16,216. 80, as payment in full for services and products delivered in the absence of a lawful purchase order and that the clerk of the board of supervisors is hereby authorized and ordered to place said invoices upon the claims docket for payment by the Madison County Board of Supervisors.
