NARRATIVE DATA

HERTISTINE LATIKER OR GRIFFIN

On Saturday, December 7th, 2025, at approximately 2144 hours, I, Deputy Michael Spann, was notified by dispatch that the Leake County Sheriff's Department was chasing a silver BMW and that they were passing Red Dog Road heading south towards Madison County. I advised dispatch that I would have spikes set up at Gin Road and Highway 43.

HERTISTINE LATIKER OR GRIFFIN

I deployed my spikes, and I observed two vehicles traveling at a high rate of speed. The first vehicle was a silver Honda CR-V with tag number (6167ED). The second vehicle, which was following very close behind the Honda, was a silver BMW, the car that Leake County was pursuing.

Both vehicles ran over the spike strips. The Honda was the only vehicle that sustained two flat tires in the front.

Leake County continued to pursue the BMW heading south on Highway 43.

I spoke with the driver of the Honda, who was later identified as Shavonda Griffin. She stated she was not injured. I observed two of the front tires being flat. I provided Griffin with a case number.

While speaking with Griffin. Dispatch advised me that the residence of 5360 Highway 43 called and stated the car we were chasing possibly threw something out the window and that a car dropped someone off in the road in front of his house. They advised a Black male was in their yard looking for something.

I arrived on scene near the homeowner at 5360 highway 43, and I observed a Black male, who was later identified as Robert Johnson, walking on the side of the road near the residence of 5360 Highway 43. I told Johnson to stop and come speak with me. At this time I observed Johnson throw something on the ground. I immediately placed

While placing Johnson in handcuffs. I observed some green leafy substance presumed to be marijuana in a clear bag on the ground near Johnson. Johnson initially denied the marijuana being his but later took ownership of it. Johnson stated his prescription for his mouth flew out the window of his brother's car, and his brother dropped him off in the street to look for it. Johnson denied being a part of the car Leake County was chasing.

I placed Johnson in my custody and transported him to the Madison County Detention Center, where he was charged with (possession of paraphernalia). The marijuana was logged and placed in the vault. End of report.
