

To: Madison County Board of Supervisors.

I'm writing to request that The Board consider granting permission to work with the Madison County Sheriff's office, and a few of their personnel for a few interior and exterior sequences during the filming of, "The Tempering, " a film shooting in Canton, Mississippi and surrounding areas. Three crime scenes with a few deputies and marked cars in evidence, as well as a few scenes in a Sheriff's station movie set, and if we could use some uniformed deputies, to add legitimacy to those scenes and would be greatly appreciated and would enhance the film, giving the presence of the Sheriff's department in the context of the murder investigation that the film centers around.

During driving scenes, some assistance with traffic control would be appreciated, and as always, we understand that if deputies get a call, they must go do their job, which always comes first.

"The Tempering" is being produced under the MS film office incentive program and with the cooperation of the Canton Department of Tourism and is in no way derogatory of law enforcement. Sheriff Randy Tucker and Chief Jeremy Williams have approved the foregoing, subject to Board approval.

I have shot many films with the approval of the board and the participation of the Madison County Sheriff's Department, including "The Minute You Wake Up, Dead," starring Morgan Freeman, and the Pureflix, world, premiere movie, "Finding Faith," and "Sisters on the Run" AKA "Broken Ties," most recently, "Lazarus the Awakening", sequel to the first ever TUBI premier movie, "The Girl in the River," and have always had a wonderful experience.

Our schedule is to prep for three weeks starting April 1 in Canton, and start shooting April 20, for 12 days over 2 consecutive weeks.
