RE: **Mississippi Voters Leagues Initiative**

I am overjoyed with excitement to announce that the Mississippi Association of Supervisors Minority Caucus (MAS-MC) has officially launched the Mississippi Voters Leagues Initiative. In our quest to launch/reactivate Voters Leagues in counties with Minority Supervisor leadership, we are hopeful that this very impactful initiative will resonate with all Mississippians in ways that will have outcomes that exceed our expectations.

Mississippi and its citizens are currently facing somewhat unprecedented challenges. These challenges can best be addressed through active citizen engagement. The leadership of MAS-MC strongly believes that Voters Leagues are needed in every Mississippi county to:

- **Empower citizens, protect voting rights, and ensure that every voice has a say in shaping community and national policy.**
- **Increase participation and ensure that all elected leaders reflect the needs of the people.**

The key goals and activities of the Voters Leagues Initiative are:

- **Voter Education**
Equipping citizens with the knowledge and confidently participate in elections, from registration to casting a vote.
- **Voter Registration**
Sharing general, yet specific information on what is needed to ensure access to the voting booth. Engaging throughout the State of Mississippi to ensure citizen's required information is accurate/updated prior to elections.
- **Voter Participation**
Ensuring that eligible citizens are involved and engaged in the electoral process, including registering to vote, casting ballots, and taking other active steps to influence election outcomes.

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I am requesting that every MAS-MC supervisor participate in and support this MAS-MC project. When we increase Voter Education, Voter Registration, and Voter Participation we increase citizen engagement in our communities. Citizen engagement is a critical component to community change. We need change!
