Gentlemen:

Per Madison County's recycling contract with Waste Management, the company is allowed an annual rate increase based upon the increase in the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (All Items).

The CPI increase for the prior yearly calculation period is 1.37 percent, which amounts to a 5-cent per house increase. Effective with the next billing period, our rate will increase from \$3.45 per house to \$3.50 per house.

Waste Management is currently picking up recycling from 3,468 houses. This figure includes the recent addition of Lost Rabbit. The new monthly bill will be \$12,138.
