As you assess road needs throughout the county, Madison County Schools would like to make you aware that we are expanding our facilities at Mannsdale Elementary School which is located at 443 Mannsdale Road. A turn lane at Stribling Road and Hwy 463 would greatly facilitate traffic flow at this location.

In addition, we continue to experience increased enrollment in the Germantown attendance zone. As you are aware, we have three large schools (Germantown High School, Germantown Middle School, and the Madison County Career and Technical Center) all located in very close proximity off of Calhoun Parkway. A deceleration lane on Calhoun Parkway would greatly help traffic flow in and out of Germantown Middle School.
