I received two road claims yesterday on a pothole on Weisenberger Rd. (west side of RR tracks). This is the same pothole that we paid all those claims on in November. This is a very deep hole that apparently reoccurs after a heavy rain. I actually saw this hole yesterday morning on the drive to work and contacted the road dept. to let them know and later that morning I received the two claims. The road dept. did go out and fill the hole early yesterday morning.

I wanted to know how you wanted me to handle these claims. If we went by policy, it has been repaired, so we are not liable, however it is a problematic area and we've paid claims on it previously. Just looking for your guidance on how you would like for me to process them.
