Dear Margaret "Emily" Anderson:

The Red Book (9th Edition) provides that the Center for Government and Community Development is to notify you annually of your Track II certification status within the legislatively-mandated Mississippi Education and Certification Program. Currently, in addition to being a certified appraiser, you hold the following three (3) advanced levels of certification:

Assessment Evaluator I (AEI) Assessment Evaluator II (AEII) Mississippi Assessment Evaluator (MAE)

According to Section 27-3-52 of the *Mississippi Code* which was adopted by the Legislature in 1980, you may now qualify for a \$3,500 annual financial bonus.

When any tax assessor and/or his deputies or assistants attend and successfully complete all qualifications pursuant to the Mississippi Education and Certification Program and receive the certification level of Track II, Evaluator 1, they shall receive an additional One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) annually beginning the next fiscal year after completion.

... and receive the certification level of Track II, Evaluator II, they shall receive an additional One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) annually

 \dots and receive the certification level of Mississippi Assessment Evaluator (MAE), they shall receive an additional One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) annually \dots

You are encouraged to continue your participation in this program and to seek a professional designation through the International Association of Assessing Officers or the Mississippi Appraisal Board. Also, please be aware that in order to retain your basic and Track II levels of certification, you must annually receive recertification through attending the annual Recertification Course or through attendance of an approved International Association of Assessing Officers (IAAO) course or approved Mississippi Chapter of the IAAO workshop.
