I serve as counsel to the developers of The Town of Livingston. As you are aware, Livingston Mercantile Store and The Gathering restaurant have recently opened at the Town of Livingston, and development of other retail establishments is nearing completion. One business in particular, Farmer's Table Cooking School, is complete and ready to open.

As part of the development of The Town of Livingston, improvements to the intersection of Highways 463 and 22 are underway per Mississippi Department of Transportation ("MDOT") specifications. This Board has previously granted an exception for Livingston Mercantile Store and The Gathering restaurant to receive a Certificate of Occupancy as the highway improvements were being conducted. There have been no traffic issues since the opening of Livingston Mercantile Store and The Gathering, and none expected with the opening of Farmer's Table Cooking School. The highway improvements are more than 65% complete, and final completion is anticipated within the next two to three weeks depending on weather conditions. MDOT has been monitoring and approving the improvements as they progress. There are no anticipated issues with final MDOT approval.

Therefore, please consider this as the request of the developers of The Town of Livingston for the Board of Supervisors of Madison County to grant an exception, and approve a Certificate of Occupancy to be issued to the Farmer's Table Cooking School as the highway improvements progress.
