Gentlemen,

Because of a Classification error on the Land Use, as per Section 27-35-50 Ms. Code, for the acreage assessed on these 7 parcels (see page 2 of 2) for the 2013 tax year, the Tax Assessor feels that these individuals are due a Refund for overpayment of their 2013 taxes.

Tri-State Consultants, Inc. was contracted by the Madison County Tax Assessor in 2010 to audit/re-check every parcel in Madison County that had Land Use value applied and to update these parcels in our system. The only aerial photos that were available at the time of this contract were flown in 2008 and when viewing the 2008 aerial photos, all of the parcels/acreage listed on the attached sheet appeared to be Agricultural Crop land and was assessed/classed as such beginning with the 2012 tax roll. Therefore all of these Refunds for overpayment of 2013 taxes are due to each individual parcel/acreage being assessed/classed as <u>Cultivatable land</u>, which is under the <u>Agricultural Crop use code</u> (Incorrectly) and should have been assessed/classed as <u>Uncultivable land</u>, which is under the <u>Forestry use code</u>. All of these parcels/acreage were planted in pine trees from 2006-2008.

Our office has confirmed that a Classification error did occur on these parcels for the 2013 tax year and I have calculated the total amount of overpayment of taxes for the 2013 year for each parcel. On behalf of the property owners the Tax Assessor respectfully request the Board of Supervisors approve all of these Refunds as shown on page 2 of 2, listed by; Parcel #, Owners name, mailing address, total acreage assessed on each parcel, and the total amount of Refund due for each parcel. <u>Note:</u> # 7 on above list, Parcel # 103*G*-25-004: The total taxes for 2013 for this parcel was \$1,913.38 which is for (267acres) and Imp's (Single Residence, Barn, & Utility shed). The Refund amount figured for this parcel is for the acreage only, the Improvements were assessed correctly for 2013. All of the other parcels were assessed with land only for 2013.
