Gentlemen:

The Board recently approved advertising for one or more L-3 Mobile Vision In-Car Video Camera Systems and one or more L-3 Mobile Vision Wireless Access Points. Two bids were received, one of which does not meet the specifications.

It is my recommendation that the board take the following action:

- (1) Reject the bid of Health Bideau for failure to meet the specifications. Health Bideau submitted a bid for a Digital Ally DMV-800 video system and wireless access points, which does not meet the required specifications as approved by the board.
- (2) Award the bid to TCSware, Inc. for 13 L-3 Mobile Vision In-Car Video Camera Systems at a price of \$5,040.11 each (13 x \$5,041.11 = \$65,521.43) and three L-3 Mobile Vision Wireless Access Points at a cost of \$899 each (3 x \$899 = \$2,697).

The total purchase is \$68,218.43.

Gentlemen:

The Madison County Sheriff's Department is requesting to purchase additional L-3 Mobile Vision In-Car Video Camera Systems for use in patrol cars and additional Outdoor Access Point for transfer of video to the storage server.

The Sheriff's department currently uses an L-3 Mobile Vision In-Car Video Camera System in its patrol cars. In 2014, the County purchased an L-3 Mobile Vision server and back-up storage system, 31 L-3 Mobile vision in-car cameras, and outdoor wireless access point for transfer of video from the patrol cars to the server. The cost of this purchase was \$32,467.

The specifications must be restricted to the L-3 Vision Flashback 3 In-Car Video System and the L3 Outdoor Access Points for the equipment to be compatible with and operate with the Sheriff's Department's current equipment, which the County has considerable funds invested in.

I hope you can help me with this matter. The City of Biloxi Police Deptartment has used L3 Flashback 3 in-car videos for more than a year now and are pleased with the system and its functionality. We are still in the process of replacing other

systems which did not survive in the world of a patrol car. Even further, the vendor, TCS Ware, works diligently to resolve any issues or complications encountered and to deliver outstanding support.

We saw that that the L3 systems were accepted by the DFA in the first quarter (or so) of this year but I am now unable to find the systems listed on a state contract site. Although TCS Ware is sole source vendor for L3, it is our understanding that the selection was made which would allow for additional agencies, other than solely DPS, to purchase from this state contract. This greatly eases the burden of municipal ordering in that quotes, sole source letters from the manufacturer and the like are no longer needed.

We have pending monies from the Edward Byrne Grant and other sources sitting by as we are ready to purchase the systems but, as of yet, cannot find them. Can you offer some insight as to when they will be listed and available for purchase? I believe the system as listed for the state should be roughly \$4,700 with a 64 GB SD card and crash sensor.
