ORDER SETTING FEE FOR SPECIAL MASTER

It appearing unto the Court that a special master should be appointed to hear Petitions for Temporary Relief pled within divorce and domestic abuse matters within Madison County Chancery Court.

It is therefore ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that effective January 1, 2015, James Christopher Walker, a duly licensed and practicing attorney be, and he hereby is, appointed Special Master, with full power and authority to hear and determine such Temporary Relief and to otherwise exercise all powers expressly or impliedly granted within and pursuant to Section 9-5-255 of the Mississippi Code Annotated of 1972, as amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that said special master shall be allowed a fee of \$3,000.00 per month, as detailed within Section 25-7-35 of Mississippi Code Annotated of 1972, as amended. It is expressly understood that said Special Master is not an employee of Madison County, this Court, or the State of Mississippi and, further, that nothing about this Order of Appointment or Mr. Walker's services pursuant hereto shall be construed to create or establish such a relationship.
