Good afternoon Ms. Miller,

I am writing on behalf of the City of Canton regarding the 2014 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG). I spoke with Chief Brown this morning. He asked me to forward this information to you via email.

As you may be aware, each year the City and County share in an annual allocation of grant funds provided to states and units of local governments with critical funding necessary to support a range of program areas including law enforcement, prosecution and court programs including indigent defense, prevention and education programs, corrections and community corrections, drug treatment and enforcement, crime victim and witness initiatives, and planning, evaluation, and technology improvement programs.

The City was awarded \$12,342 in FY14 JAG funds to share with Madison County. I've attached the documentation which details the grant award for your review. We would like to present the grant to the Board of Supervisors and determine the Board's intention regarding these funds for FY2014. The County share of the grant is \$6,171.50. Should the Board decide to expend its share of these funds, we will need to draft an MOU to this effect.

2014 MISSISSIPPI JAG ALLOCATIONS

Listed below are all jurisdictions in the state that are eligible for FY 2014 JAG funding, as determined by the JAG formula. If your jurisdiction is listed with another city or county government in a shaded area, you are in a funding disparity. In this case, the units of local government must develop a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and apply for an award with a single, joint application.

Finding your jurisdiction:(1) Disparate jurisdictions are listed in shaded groups below, in alphabetic order by county.(2) Eligible individual allocations are listed alphabetically below the shaded, disparate groupings.

Counties that have an asterisk (*) under the "Eligible Individual Allocation" column did not submit the level of violent crime data to qualify for a direct award from BJA, but are in the disparate grouping indicated by the shaded area. The JAG legislation requires these counties to remain a partner with the local jurisdictions receiving funds and must be a signatory on the required Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). Disparate jurisdictions do not need to abide by the listed individual allocations, which are provided for information only. Jurisdictions in a funding disparity are responsible for determining individual amounts within the Eligible Joint Allocation and for documenting individual allocations in the MOU.
