The general scope of the TIF Plan is a proposal that the City of Madison ("Ciby") and Madison County may issue Tax Increment Financing Revenue Bonds. Notes, or other similar debt instruments (the Bonds) in one or more series in a total principal amount not to exceed \$12,000,000 in order to provide funds nebessary to construct various public infrastructure Improvements in connection with the Project (as defined in the TIF Plan), including, but not limited to, installation of utilities such as water, sanitary sewer and natural gas lines, relocation of utilities installation and relocation of electrical installation and relocation of readways with our and gutter, parking, sidewalks, installation of storm drainage, construction of roadways with our and gutter, parking, sidewalks, installation of traffic signalization and signage, grading, lighting and landscaping of rights-of-way, construction of parks and public recreational facilities and related infrastructure and other property necessary for the installation of the installation of

The Bonds will be secured solely by the City's pledge of up to one hundred percent (100%) of the increased reat and personal property ad valorem taxes within the TIF District and a pledge of up to one hundred percent (100%) of the City's increased retail sales taxes rebated from the State of Mississippi pertaining to the TIF District in addition, the TIF District in addition, the TIF District in addition, the TIF District in addition the TIF District for the construction of certain parks and personal property ad valorem taxes within the TIF District for the construction of certain parks and public recreational facilities and related infrastructure.

The pledges described hereinabove will never be a general obligation of the County or the City nor will hely be secured by the full talth, credit, and taxing power of either the County or the City nor will they create any other pecuniary lability on the City, nor will they create any other pecuniary lability on the part of the County or the City other than the pledge of the incremental increase in the aid valorem that the case and rebated sales tax set forth above.

The County intends to enter into an inter-local Agreement with the City to implement the TIF Plan and allow for efficient use of proceeds of the Bonds to pay the cost of the intrastructure improvements.

Construction of the Infrastructure improvements and payment of the Bonds will be paid as set forth in the TIF Plan and will not require an increase in ad valorem taxes within the County or the City.

The County and the City may exercise their authority under the Act, individually or jointly pursuant to are inter-local cooperation agreement as authorized by the Act.

A copy of the TIF Plan is available for examination in the Madison County Chancery Clerk's Office.

This hearing is being called and conducted and the TIF Plan has been prepared as authorized and required y Sections 21-45-1 et.seq. Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.
