Purpose of Site Visit: Regular Progress Meeting and Site Visit & Roofing Pre-Install Meeting

Work Currently in Progress / Complete:

- 1 Exterior Plaster Work is in progress (Cornices and Columns) PCG states they are 95% complete. Figures 1 and 2
- Courtroom walls, ceiling and trim have been painted. Some limited plaster work and painting remains. Figures 3 and 4
- 3 FOYER 201 and STAIR 202 Plaster and Painting is complete. Figure 5
- 4 Plaster repairs and painting is complete on the first floor. PCG painted all walls in the corridor. Figure 6
- 5 HVAC Control Work will be starting next week.
- 6 Roofing and Sheet Metal Work will be starting soon. Weather dependant.
- 7 "Skylite" wall insulation is scheduled in with roofing activities.
- 8 Romy noted that the Bee Keeper has been on-site and eliminated the honey bees at the North Entry Cornice area.
- Mock-up Samples for the "Lego" trim and "Flower" detail was available for review. Detailing was crafted from Spanish Cedar. Both were found acceptable and approved for installation. Romy noted there will be about 4 "Legos" that will need to be replaced Figure 7
- 10 An investigative area was cut into the floor to determine how the additional floor boxes will be installed. Work is scheduled to begin next week. Boxes and lines will be laid out on the floor for review by the County prior to starting installation. Figure 8
- 11 90% of the underground drainage piping has been installed. Some basins, cleanouts and connections, including tie-in into the street drains, remains.
- 12 Plaster Repair Work and painting is complete in OFFICE 106, including ceiling and light fixture reinstallation.
- 13 It is BSA's understanding that actual Carpet Sample has been ordered from SHAW for final review and approval. PCG to verify status of carpet with Supplier/Shaw Rep.
- 14 PCG has polished the Brass Rail at the balcony in the Courtroom.















Items Observed and/or Discussed On-Site:

- 15 PCG will verify and address Exterior Plaster/Stucco Bonding Agent being used to make sure it is what was submitted. **Figure 9**
- 16 PCG noted Masonry Mock-Up work is scheduled to be installed next week.
- 17 "Sharp" paint edges on trim in Courtroom need to be sanded down smooth.

Meeting Items:

- 18 Fully executed Change Order #1 has been distributed to all parties.
- 19 Danny Lee requested receipt of BSA Field Report and PCG's Meeting Minutes be submitted ASAP in order to give an update to the Board on Monday, June 1, 2015 at 9:00. PCG's Minutes will be attached to BSA Field Report.
- 20 PCG will prepare and submit Draft Application for Payment #3 SOV to BSA for review. Since the meeting, SOV has been received and approved amounts for the preparation of the Final Application for payment. Jonathan will send Originals overnight. Upon receipt, Craig will process and E-Mail Danny Lee for inclusion on the Agenda for Monday's Board Meeting. Originals will follow.
- 21 Since Change Order #1 was approved, (2) Floor Boxes at Courtroom were eliminated and conduit has been changed to 1 ½" in lieu of the original 1".
- 22 Removal of the Crepe Myrtles was discussed. He is waiting for permission to do this. PCG will cut, however, do to the risk of damaging existing utilities and waterproofing, they prefer to not have to remove the remaining stumps and roots. Since the meeting, it hs been agreed upon that PCG will cut down and the County will haul away and remove the remaining stump.
- 23 BSA will provide PCG (and the County) with a color for the Doors, Panel and Wood Cap Trim in the Courtroom.
- 24 If shutdown is required for HVAC Control Work, PCG should notify Danny to coordinate with building occupants.
- 25 Jonathan stated that he will be submitting an Alternate Sub-Contractor to do the Masonry Work.
- 26 Roofing Pre-Installation Meeting took place following Progress Meeting. See Meeting Notes.
- 27 Paramount Construction Group's Progress Meeting Minutes are attached.

The Next Regular Progress Meeting will be on Wednesday, June 24, 2015 @ 9:00 a.m.
