
## IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF MADISON COUNTY, MISSI\$SIPP



## **ORDER ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION**

THIS MATTER is before the Court regarding representation of indigent defendants, and with the Court being aware of an order for such purpose entered in this Court on October 1, 1984, the Court finds it is necessary to further address the matter of representation of indigent defendants in the Justice Court of Madison County, Mississippi. Consistent with the order entered in this Court on September 15, 2014, and with the Court being informed that the number of cases in the Justice Court of Madison County, Mississippi has increased as a result of the effects of the implementation of House Bill 585 passed the 2014 Legislative Session, the Court further finds that effective October 1, 2015, Gregory J. Webber should continue as a public defender in the Justice Court of Madison County, Mississippi and for such services should receive the monthly sum of \$3,683.33, subject to income tax withholding and with no additional benefits, with the first payment to be due on October 31, 2015.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that effective October 1, 2015, Gregory J. Webber should continue as a public defender in the Justice Court of Madison County, Mississippi and for such services should receive the monthly sum of \$3,683.33, subject to income tax withholding and with no additional benefits, with the first payment to be due on October 31, 2015.
