It further appearing that said services rendered per the request of Madison County, Mississippi by Ozborn Communications, LLC, and a copy of said Resolution denying said claims are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes; and

It further appearing that the Madison County Board of Supervisors acknowledges that the service was requested by and on behalf of Madison County, but that the proper documentation via purchase order from the county was not utilized; and

It further appearing that § 19-13-31 authorizes the Circuit Court to order for payment of said service which was requested and received by Madison County,

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but for which proper purchase order and documentation was not completed;

It further appearing that Ozborn Communications, LLC, vendor in this matter, has agreed to the substance of the aforementioned Complaint, has entered its Joinder to this Application and Complaint, has waived service of process through its authorized representative, and has Agreed to the Form of the Order in this matter; and


And the Court having jurisdiction of the subject matter and the parties is of the opinion that said claim should be paid pursuant to § 19-13-31.
