Mr. Warnock,

I wish to draw your attention to a hazardous condition on Distribution Drive in Madison County, Mississippi. Several months ago drainage work was done on Distribution Drive just west of the Bear Creek Water Associations facility. This work called for the removal of asphalt on Distribution Drive. After the work was completed the asphalt was not replaced. A loose gravel material was used as a filler and since then has continuously eroded and created a hazard for all users of this road. The loose material has been replaced once, but due to the large amount of traffic from our thriving industrial center it has again failed and is in dire needs of a permanent solution.

We have contacted numerous county officials on this matter, but have yet to obtain a solution to correcting the hazardous issue that is a threat to the general public's health, safety and welfare. This is a continuously degrading problem that could use a solution as soon as possible so that our industrial community can continue to grow and support our county.

Secondly, I would like to address the need of a traffic light at the inter section of Distribution Drive and Gluckstadt Road. In the mornings and afternoons traffic is cued from Bozeman Road to the interstate not allowing traffic to enter Gluckstadt Road from Distribution Drive. This is further exacerbated by the three-day cares with numerous parents dropping off and picking up children in the morning and afternoons.

Since the installation of the red light at Gluckstadt Road and Calhoun Parkway traffic flow has continued to degrade. We have estimated that we are loosing 1 hour a day with employees sitting in cars trying to get to job sites.
