SECOND AMENDED ORDER SETTING SALARY OF STAFF ATTORNEY

There having come on for consideration the matter of the apportionment of funds for the position of staff attorney for Judge James C. Walker, Chancellor for Place Three of the Eleventh Chancery Court District, it is hereby ordered by the undersigned Chancellor that \$42,750.00 shall be apportioned per year, plus benefits, for the position of Staff Attorney for Chancellor James C. Walker. Richerish Johnson is hereby appointed to the position of Law Clerk II for Chancery Judge James C. Walker in the 11th Chancery Court District. Said salary is consistent with the AOC Trial Court Support Staff Salary Ranges.

Effective January 1, 2016, the salary of said Law Clerk II Attorney shall be funded on a monthly basis first by application from the AOC support staff funds of Chancellor James C. Walker and then from the funds of the counties in the Eleventh Chancery Court District, to be prorated as follows:

Madison County	60%
Leake County	20%
Yazoo County	10%
Holmes County	10%


