There next came on for consideration the site plan amendment of Anthony Morrison for property located at 102 Hazelton Cove. No one was present to present the site plan. Upon Motion by Commissioner McKay to table the request, seconded by Commissioner Billingsley, with all voting "aye," the motion to table the site plan amendment passed.

There next came on for consideration the site plan of Capitol Body Shop for a new addition to their business.
